In light of the current shutdown to stop the spread of COVID-19, UNDP, Bangladesh, is e-launching Transformers, an illustrated e-book dedicated to the stories of 17 young Bangladeshis whose work impacts the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDG's).

Transformers features 17 young changemakers whose work is community-focused, innovative and altruistic. It includes the story of Mahmud Hasan Tabib & Rana, also known as the rap duo Gully Boy, whose lyrics address the pressing issue of poverty, Ikram Uddin Abir, founder of Procheshta Food Bank which distributes leftover meals to the needy, Kamruzzaman Shadhin, an artist that created a dolphin-conservation boat, and Farhana Rashid or 'Toilet Apa' an architect who installs public toilets for women in Bangladesh, among many other fascinating stories. The book is meant to nurture quality reading habits through the stories of homegrown, Bangladeshi role models.
