

## Bangla Poetry Recitation & Creative Writing Competitions at Junior Section of

### Sir John Wilson School

Sir John Wilson School recently hosted a Bangla Poetry Recitation and Creative Writing Competition to encourage students to embrace their mother tongue and showcase their literary talents. The event took place from February 17th to 20th, 2024 with participation from students across different grade levels.

Students from KG-II to Class 2 took part in the poetry recitation segment where they were provided with age-appropriate poems in advance to memorise. Teachers played a crucial role in helping students understand the content and meanings of challenging words during their regular lessons. The competition was conducted in two stages: an initial classroom round followed by a final round on 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2025 where selected students performed on stage. The top three performers will be honored with certificates recognising their achievements.

Meanwhile, students of Class 3 and 4 engaged in the Bangla Creative Writing Competition, honing their skills in essay and story writing. Participants were given specific topics to write about, and the best three pieces from each section will be awarded certificates for excellence. Additionally, the top write-ups will be published in the school yearbook, providing students with a platform to showcase their creativity.

This initiative not only highlighted students' dedication to their mother language but also strengthened their enthusiasm for learning Bangla in a meaningful way. The school extends its gratitude to all students for their participation and to the Bangla teachers for their invaluable guidance and support in making this event a success. Looking ahead, Sir John Wilson School remains committed to organising similar events that cultivate a deeper appreciation for language and literature among students.
