In January 2025, Sir John Wilson School hosted Spellathon - an annual event for the students from KG-I to Class 4. This event aims to enhance students' English spelling skills and develop enthusiasm for learning new words. Spellathon provides a platform for students to expand their vocabulary by studying a wide range of words across various subjects. Depending on their grade level, students receive a word list to learn by heart with over a month to prepare. During English classes, teachers guide and support the students in understanding these words alongside their regular curriculum. The competition encourages healthy competitiveness among students and lifts their confidence. Participation is open to all students, and those achieving full marks receive certificates in recognition of their excellence. However, Spellathon is not just a spelling competition; it carries a meaningful purpose. Parents are encouraged to contribute monetarily for each correctly spelled word with all proceeds dedicated to activities that benefit society and support those in need. At the moment 3 students from JAAGO and 2 students from Mojar School are sponsored for their education with the money we collect from this Spellathon Initiative. We believe that this initiative helps students develop a sense of responsibility towards their community and country. By participating, they learn that their achievements can positively impact others, particularly the less privileged of the society.
